Our one-to-one chats take place via video call on Teams. There will be a link to click in our email to you which will start the call, and you won't need to install any software.

Your interview will be hosted by our Managing Director, School Principal or a Senior Teacher. You'll have an opportunity to talk about yourself, what you are hoping to achieve, and we can discuss our courses and their suitability for you. We can explain what to expect in the new academic year as well as answer any questions that you may have. It is important that you inform us in your interview if you have any relevant medical conditions and/or specific learning difficulties that could affect your time on the course. You should allow up to half an hour for the appointment.

Following your one-to-one, our Registrar will contact you by email. If you have been offered a place on one of our professional courses the enrolment form and instructions will be attached. If we do not think the course will be suitable for you for any reason, we will let you know, and offer alternative advice.

If you have studied at degree level before in the UK, this will not be needed.
